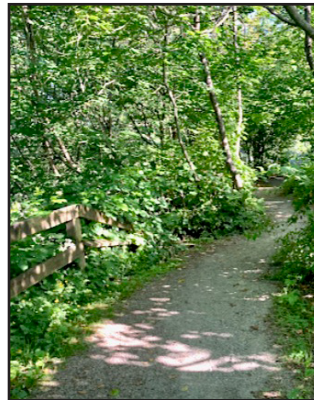
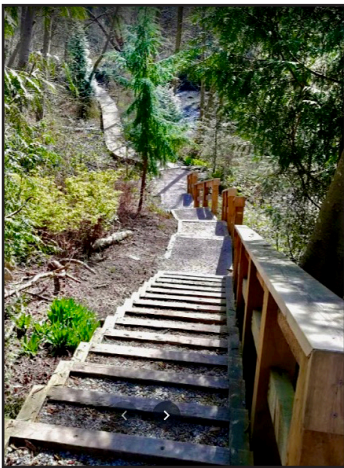
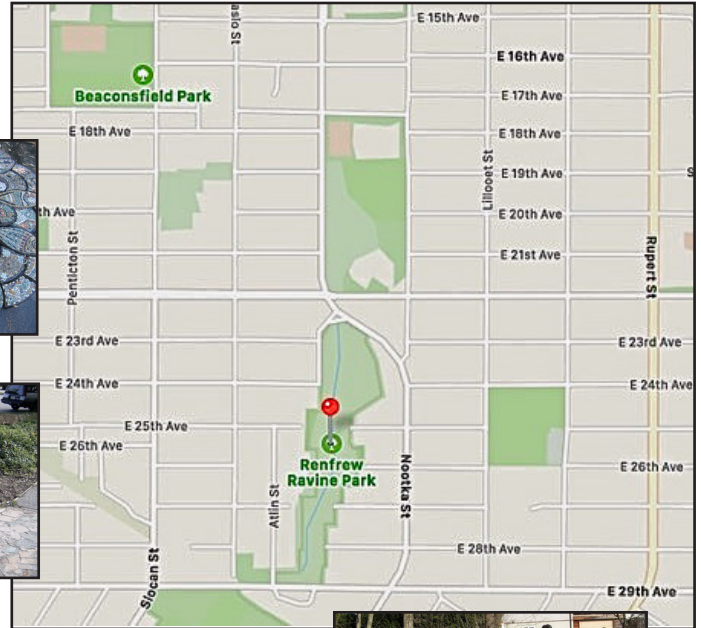


Still Creek Coho/Chum Release Site

A participatory Labyrinth is located at 27th on the eastside of the ravine.



Take the stairs and follow the path to the nurse tree and wooden platform.

Water from Still Creek flows into Burnaby Lake, which joins with the Brunette River and finally enters the Fraser River in New Westminster.
